My element on the west front spotted two enemy while after the saws. The 2 individuals were trying to get to B Company pack, killed them. We recievedmore fire from the ridge across the draw, returned fire and withdrew. Artillery is being employed at this time.
16	1000	(U) To NCS from B Co There is a dud bomb just to the west of the S JC LZ. We can't blow trees for we may set the bomb off. We need the chain saw.

- 39 2220 (U) To Bm from A Company A Company reports movement to the south Bde MK of his fire base. We are going to fire light organics on the suspected position.
